Read the story and highlight all the LONG I words (ie, igh, i\_e). Don't let Short I words trick you! Write all the highlighted words at the bottom.


Last night, at nine o'clock, five of my best

Search the room for Long I words. Identify the spelling pattern and write them in the correct boxes below.









# Dictionary





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
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### Sentence Scramble
